LiveHealth Online psychology visit copays will not change and will continue to mirror the mental health office visit copay.

HMO-POS

- Moving to an "Open Access" plan, which means you **no longer have to have a referral** when going to a specialist.
- You may designate a Primary Care Physician (PCP); but if you do not choose one, a default PCP of "Open Access" will be printed on your card. You may keep your current PCP or ask Anthem to change it at any time.
- Outpatient home infusion service benefit is changed from the deductible + 20% coinsurance to a flat \$35 copay.
- All outpatient mental health and substance abuse disorder visits will be a \$20 copay.

PPO

- No changes other than the LiveHealth Online copay.
